Conexion Outcome Objectives

- Connect to College
 - a. Increase matriculation rate from 8.9% to 13.9%
- 2. Connect to Completion
- Connect to Career and Transfer
 - a. Increase transfer to 4-year colleges by 10% (59% baseline).
 - b. 75% of students in Capstone courses can competently articulate the role of their academic learning in career readiness.

- The Language and Culture Mentorship Program will pair an alumnus/alumnae and a current student in the same major or discipline and engage in various career development activities (a tour to 4-year institution or workplace and/or a visit to cultural institutions)
- Each activity should be at least 2 hours long. In-person activities are preferred, but virtual activities are also acceptable (e.g., virtual museum visit etc)

Project schedule (Fall 2021)

- We are hoping to have one or two pilot event in November and December 2021. Possible dates are:
 - Monday, November 29 Friday, December 3, 2021
 - Monday, December 6 Friday, December 10, 2021
 - Wednesday, December 15 Thursday, December 23, 2021
- Once we establish the date/time and the location of the event, we will find a current student who is interested in your event. We will need to know:
 - Two possible date/time slots for the event
 - The location of the event
 - For whom the event recommended (e.g., International Studies students, Spanish-English Translation students Japanese option students)

An example reflection set for a campus visit activity

- 1. Introduction of the paired partner [see the examples on the next slides]
- 2. 3-4 short introductions of the campus facilities (e.g., the academic department, the admission office, labs, library, cafeterias, student lounge, gym etc.)
- 3. A summary reflection





The alumnus writes about his current school or workplace for the student.






Photos and videos


